# Hadley Public Library Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes January 9, 2024

Meeting convened at 7:00 p.m. in the Hadley Public Library Meeting Room Trustees in attendance: Lynne Latham-Chair, Jessica Kem, Jo-Ann Konieczny, Susan Mooring. Jack Czajkowski-guest.

## Opportunity for public comment:

Board Vacancies: The current Board of Library Trustees will meet jointly with the Select Board, on January 17, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. via Zoom or in person, to vote the appointed candidate, Jack Czajkowski, for the interim position on the Board of Library Trustees. No other candidates have been secured.

## Director"s Report:

- FY 2025 Budget submitted on 01/05/2024 to Select Board and Town Administrator
- Staffing has remained the same despite patron growth
- Approximately 9% budget increase submitted, primarily due to proposed staff increase
- Programming budget is primarily funded by Friends of the Library (\$6,745). Patrick will ask the Friends of the Library to award this amount at one time.
- Public computer usage is up.
- State Aid in the amount of \$7,131.18 has been awarded to HPL.
- Work has begun on the Access panel on the front doors.
- Roof RFPs have been sent out and 3 RFPs have been received with estimates of \$4,000, \$7,000., and \$15,000. Next steps are to have a conversation with Mark Sullivan-Project Manager during building construction, and inquire if he would be willing to offer comments or suggest others to do the work.
- Trustees discussed going to Mark first, and then determining next steps.

• Strategic Planning- Jo-Ann reported that the January 10, 2024 meeting has been moved to February 28, 2024.
