

HADLEY HISTORICAL COMMISSION MINUTES--11/18/14

Present: Tom McGee, Margaret Freeman, Linda Ziegenbein, Linda Harris, Marjorie Pratt Townsend (guest)

Meeting called to order at 7:00. Margaret Freeman moved that the October minutes be approved. Tom McGee seconded the motion. All approved.

Willie Danylieko from the Building Committee came to the meeting to talk about putting a new roof on Town Hall. We once again reminded him that the roof must be historically appropriate and that CPA funds can be used to pay for historic restorations including this roof. Tom McGee will go to the Historical Society to find old pictures of Town Hall. Linda Ziegenbein will check with the Northampton Historical Commission to see if they have metal roofs on historic buildings. She will e-mail HHC members with results and Ginger will send this information to the Building Committee.

We decided that we would honor Peg Tudyryn and Marla Miller's years of service on the HHC with a framed photo and a certificate. Marjorie Pratt Townsend will send Linda Harris two appropriate photographs and Linda will get them copied and framed. Tom McGee will create two certificates. Linda Harris will e-mail Tom McGee the dates that Peg and Marla served on the HHC. The framed photographs and certificates will be brought to our January meeting.

We agreed to nominate Peg Tudyryn for this year's Fred Oakley award. Margaret Freeman and Linda Harris will write the nomination and submit it to the Select Board.

We discussed hiring a Historical Preservationist to write a preservation restriction for North Hadley Town Hall. Margaret Freeman talked to Marla Miller and she suggested we ask Stacia Caplanson (Preservation Circuit Rider) and Elizabeth Rairigh (PVPC) for suggestions as to who could write the preservation restriction. Ginger Goldsbury will call Stacia and Elizabeth for their suggestions.

Linda Harris moved that we adjourn and Tom McGee seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 8:30.
