

Hadley Historical Commission Minutes for June 23, 2015 Compiled by Jeffrey Mish

Meeting came to order at 7:00 with Freeman approving the May minutes, McGee seconded.

East Street Commons

Barry Roberts presented his site plan for East Street Commons; a housing development consisting of condominiums for those aged fifty-five and older. There are seven unit types, varying in size and color. The units will have propane heat, horizontal siding, asphalt shingles, and wood trim. The roofs will all match in color.

A condo association will be responsible for the water and sewer; sewage will be incorporated into the Route 9 system.

Trees and street lights have been incorporated into the design, and a fence will be placed along the side of the development bordering the Bike Path. Similarly, arborvitaes will be placed on the edge of the development which borders a field. Kuhn-Riddle Architects is responsible for construction.

Miscellaneous

Goldsbury informed the Commission that she received a letter from the Registry of Deeds, requesting historic pictures for an exhibit. She is forwarding the letter to the Hadley Historical Society, which is more suited for such a request.

Goldsbury also received the Form B from Tom Paske, and is forwarding it to Elizabeth Rairigh.
